To Whom It May Concern:

This letter is to confirm that our BCBA (Board Certified Behavior Analyst) Clinical Supervisor Ksenia Kravtchenko has been providing BACB (Behavior Analyst Certification Board) supervision for Katrin Telin as specified by the BACB Rules and Responsibilities for supervision since March 5<sup>th</sup>, 2017. Topics that they have been covered in their training to date include; data collection and analysis, measuring and changing behaviours, ethics, supervising others, program writing, assessments, and treatment integrity for clients.

A total of 1,500 supervision hours are required by the BACB; of which Katrin received 360 hours prior to partnership with the Global Autism Project. Supervision will continue past the mandatory 1,500 hours for Global Autism Project and ABA Centrum to meet their goal of creating the first Centre of Excellence in the Czech Republic. To date, Katrin currently has 1,113 supervised hours.

During the weekly calls, there will be:

- Discussions regarding clients and ABA Centrum operations as they relate to the BCBA 4<sup>th</sup> Edition Task List as well as the Professional and Ethical Compliance Code
- Video sharing for Ms. Kravtchenko to provide feedback for Ms. Telin's performance as well as interobserver agreement
- Data and graphical analysis with assessment support
- Since November 2017, ABA Centrum received an addition call once per week for administrative needs with Global Autism Project's CEO & Founder Molly Ola Pinney

In addition to the weekly calls, ABA Centrum will receive three two-week visits by trained clinicians to offer hands-on training with ABA Centrum staff. This team will model ABA-teaching strategies, provide individualized training, and provide specific learning objectives based on their current level of achievement.
